The PMC's own Championship Season culminated in a gift of \$33 million to the Jimmy Fund. What's more, this past season marked the first time the PMC was able to give 100 percent of every rider-raised dollar directly to the Jimmy Fund.

In the 28 years since the PMC pioneered the a-thon industry, event programming has grown into a multi-billion dollar venture. Today, the PMC stands at the very pinnacle of fundraising events. Much of our success can be attributed to that which does not show up in the balance sheets—human capital. The very act of committing to a physical endurance event brings into play all parts of the human equation, and it has been my observation that when a person becomes totally engaged, the end result is usually far greater than first imagined. Thousands of PMCs can attest to this truth. More importantly, millions around the globe are the beneficiaries of cancer treatment developed by Dana-Farber scientists that are the direct result of PMCs' efforts. And this makes all of us champions too.

# Pan-Massachusetts Challenge Gives \$33 Million to the Jimmy Fund

BOSTON—The Pan-Massachusetts Challenge (PMC) raised a record-breaking \$33 million for cancer research and care at Dana-Farber Cancer Institute through its August cycling event—\$7 million more than the organization raised last year. The total sum is more than twice the amount ever raised for charity by any other athletic fundraising event. It is the single largest contribution made to the Jimmy Fund.

The check was presented to Dana-Farber President Edward J. Benz, Jr., M.D. at a ceremony attended by 500 PMC cyclists and volunteers. The contribution represents 100 percent of every rider-raised dollar, a first in the PMC's 28-year history. Since its 1980 inception, the PMC has raised more than \$200 million for the Jimmy Fund.

"Raising as much money as possible for cancer research is the foundation of the PMC culture," says Billy Starr, PMC Founder and Executive Director. "PMCers compete more about the money they raise than they do about their cycling speed."

The 27 percent increase in funds raised was primarily the result of an explosive 20 percent increase in the number of cyclists who rode in the event, according to Starr. In 2007, the PMC attracted 5,100 cycling fundraisers from 36 states and 10 countries. Also, the PMC this year created a new one-day 50-mile loop that started and ended at Babson College in Wellesley, and attracted 330 new riders who brought in an additional \$775,000. There are now seven PMC routes, which cover 360 miles of infrastructure and travel through 46 cities and towns. In addition, 23 PMC Kids Rides in Massachusetts and New Hampshire

brought in nearly \$464,000, which was \$200,000 more than the PMC Kids Rides program raised last year.

While many initially join the PMC for the athletic challenge and because of the event's reputation as a beautiful and well-supported ride, "people stay involved and raise so much because they become a part of the PMC family, reaping the personal and spiritual benefits of participating in something greater than themselves," Starr explains. "The PMC is one weekend a year when people feel deeply connected to others in a way that is hard to replicate." According to Starr, the camaraderie shared by cyclists, volunteers, and supporters is among the PMC's greatest attributes.

"The PMC and its riders are true heroes in the war on cancer," said Benz. "The money they raise is critical to our mission to eradicate cancer and enables us to invest in major new patient care and research initiatives as well as to provide support services for our patients and their families."

Founded in 1980, when 36 cyclists rode across Massachusetts and raised \$10,200 for the Jimmy Fund, the PMC is known today as the "gold standard" of athletic fundraising events, due to the unprecedented sums it raises and its consistently efficient charity pass-through rate. Through the 1990s, the PMC contributed between 92 to 99 cents of rider-raised dollars. This year's 100 percent pass-through rate is nearly unparalleled in the \$1.5 billion athletic fundraising event industry.

## Throat cancer survivor sings at Fenway

BOSTON — For PMC cyclist Denise DeSimone, singing the National Anthem at Fenway Park was a lifelong dream come true. For the tens of thousands of people in the stands during PMC Night at Fenway Park, it was an inspiring and emotional experience that brought them to their feet and put tears in their eyes.

As DeSimone walked on to the field, the announcer explained she was a survivor of stage IV throat cancer who'd undergone a radical neck dissection and radiation therapy and was left with just a whisper of a voice for months. Doctors feared she wouldn't sing again, which she'd done as a semi-professional for much of her 49 years. But on that picture perfect July evening, DeSimone proved them all wrong. "Singing at Fenway Park was absolutely one of the highlights of my life," she said.

DeSimone's life with cancer began just after she struggled to finish riding in the 2005 Pan-Mass Challenge. "I was so out of breath, I thought I was dying," said the Amesbury resident. "Turns out, I was."

Days later, DeSimone learned that a lump in the throat, which had bothered her for months, was cancer. Tumors on her tongue and throat took her ability to eat, drink and speak normally.

Despite the rapid weight loss, the painful treatments, and the inability to do the things she loved for many months, DeSimone says she would endure the entire experience again if given the choice.

"This has been quite a journey, one that I would not have missed for anything," she said. "What I learned most from this experience is people get you through it and love is all that matters." DeSimone credits the treatment she received with her survival. "I had stage IV cancer. There is no stage V. My doctor said I needed a miracle," DeSimone says.

DeSimone's cancer is now in remission and she feels great. She rode the 84-mile route from Wellesley to Bourne on August 4 with nine members of Denise's Dream Team.

"On an intellectual level, I understand why people refer to the 'battle with cancer,' or 'fighting the disease,'" she said. "But I knew I couldn't fight it. I had to learn from it and listen to it. I knew if I fought it, I was going to perpetuate whatever it was that got me sick to begin with."

"When I sing, angels come flying in," DeSimone says. "That is why God gave me my voice back." DeSimone says her mission is to share the message that cancer needs to be treated with love, not war. DeSimone says cancer is an opportunity, not a sign of the end of the line. She is currently penning two separate books related to her experience and is doing spiritual and motivational speaking at churches and cancer groups.

# Kirsten af Klinteberg leads Provincetown behind the scenes

Mid-morning on the Sunday of PMC 2006, Kirsten af Klinteberg dropped out of sight and clandestinely drove back and forth between the Provincetown Inn and the Family Finish. With her cell phone and walkie-talkie on the car seat beside her, she listened to the radio chatter between members of the Provincetown volunteer crew and PMC Command Central as they took care of issues and made decisions without her input.

Call it leadership training by fire; Kirsten's goal was to see if her team could handle the events that occur when thousands of cyclists and their families deluge two small patches of land at the end of a thin peninsula. She'd been running the Provincetown Inn and Family Finish hubsites for years, managing a team of 250 volunteers, working with the directors and administrators of Provincetown's municipal departments from parking to water and sewer, getting permits, signs, and even making apologies when necessary. Kirsten had thoughts of taking a sabbatical year off. As the PMC Head Staff member in charge of the prestigious Provincetown finish lines, she needed to be sure her crew could handle the two hub sites without her. And so she sat, waited, and listened, all the while her crew thought she was missing in action.

"Everyone was asking where Kirsten was," says Susan Kadgis, Kirsten's second-in-command and the one who would bear the responsibility if something went wrong in Kirsten's absence. "We found out later that day that she'd been listening to all of us on the walkie-talkie."

And it worked. So at the start of PMC 2007, Kirsten told the Provincetown staff that she was handing over the reigns to Susan Kadgis and Shaun Keefe for PMC 2008, during which she intended to be in Provincetown, only after having ridden 190 miles from Sturbridge. After seven years as a PMC Head Staff volunteer and two years as an employee of Dana-Farber and the PMC, it was time for her to see the PMC from the best perch of all—the bike saddle.

"We're ready to take it on," Susan says. "She's thoroughly prepared us and she has created a team that works extremely well together."

According to Susan, Kirsten's leadership style has always been one of staff empowerment. "Kirsten's motto is, 'Get me involved only in the case of death, fire, or dismemberment,'" says Susan, only half joking.

Kirsten concurs. "Shaun calls me the 'Go-To Girl,' because when someone asks me a question, I tell them where to go to get the answer," she says.

Self-effacing and modest, Kirsten has been far more than a casual leader. Over the years, she has built a respectful relationship between the PMC and Provincetown. "Provincetown does so much for the PMC," Kirsten says. "The administrators look out for us. If I forget to ask for something, they bring it anyway." At the same time, the PMC has introduced thousands of people to Provincetown who have made the town part of their summer vacations, generating welcomed revenue. "PMCers love P-town and they stay on after PMC weekend or come back at other times during the year," Kirsten says. "That's good for the town."

Kirsten understands the magnitude of the responsibility that she, her crew, and now the two new P-town Head Staff members take on in operating the PMC's Provincetown sites. "Handling the growth of the PMC, the number of people who want to come to Provincetown, and making the quick influx of thousands of people with their bikes workable for the town has always been the priority. Our goal is to make sure the PMC can give as much money to the Jimmy Fund as possible, and everyone from Provincetown residents to PMC volunteers makes sure that happens," Kirsten says.

# Pan-Mass Challenge Route Becomes Official State Bikeway

Finally, a sign we are on the right path.

This past summer, the Massachusetts Highway Department made the PMC route an official state bikeway. It issued 75 green and white metal bike route signs, and instructed public works directors in 19 towns to erect the signs at the turns along the PMC route between Sturbridge and Bourne.

The official state signs added permanence and prominence to the PMC route and the organization overall, says PMC Founder and Executive Director Billy Starr.

"We're honored and excited that the PMC is, after 28 years, an official part of the state's infrastructure," Starr said. "The PMC has grown into a national model for fundraising efficiency, and now it is a state-wide institution as well."

# NECN Wins the Boston Business Journal's Health Partner of the Year Award

After several years on the air, once they were more financially stable and entrenched as New England's 24-hour cable news station, the NECN team set out on a search for a cause through which it could give back to the community it served.

"We felt we were ready to begin committing the station to public service," said Phil Balboni, founder and president of NECN.

Balboni and his station managers created a short list of likely causes and spent time interviewing several charity organizers. But it became immediately clear when they met Billy Starr, that the PMC was the event and cause they wanted to get behind.

At that time, in 1999, the PMC had started to get solid and measurable results from its annual bike-a-thon. The event had already grown to include 2,500 cyclists and 1,800 volunteers. That year, the PMC raised \$8.7 million for Dana-Farber Cancer Institute.

Eight years later, NECN camera operators are a regular fixture alongside the throngs of riders lining up at dawn at the Sturbridge starting line. From the cowbells and cheering spectators dotting every inch of the route, the sights and sounds of the PMC make a NECN camera operator's job easy.

And while NECN has done a tremendous job covering PMC weekend from start to finish, they have been able to accomplish something far greater with their commitment to the PMC.

NECN not only became the PMC's media sponsor, the station's producers and reporters put a face on cancer each season by airing in-depth profiles of PMC cyclists. The segments show viewers what it means to have cancer, what it means to have a family member with cancer, and what it means to have access to the best medical care, treatment, and facilities at Dana-Farber Cancer Institute.

The cable station was honored for all of those things this past September when they received the Health Partner of the Year award at the Boston Business Journal Corporate Philanthropy Summit. NECN was part of an elite group of businesses and corporations who were singled out for their commitment to civic engagement and charity. The goal of the summit was to highlight and honor the unique work and innovative partnerships between companies and nonprofits.

NECN's dedication to the PMC runs top to bottom, says spokeswoman Jackie Herskovitz.

"All the reporters, producers, the people behind the desk, the camera operators—they are all completely committed," she said. "They are all members of the PMC team and part of this huge mission to fund cancer research."

NECN news director Charles Kravetz was also involved in selecting the PMC for support and said the fact the bike-a-thon benefits a universal cause was also a factor in the partnership.

"Everyone knows someone who has battled cancer," Kravetz said. "It was immediately clear that to us how much Billy was committed to this and it was also clear to see how we could contribute to its success."

Since NECN has been involved in the PMC, the event has grown from producing an \$8.7 million annual gift to one that this year contributed \$33 million to Dana-Farber. The number of cyclists increased from 1,800 to this year's 5,000, and the number of volunteers grew by about 800. "NECN has given the PMC a louder voice and a stronger presence in New England," says Starr. "There is no doubt that the PMC's continual and unparalleled growth is largely due to NECN's pervasive PMC news coverage."

# From Lab Coat to Spandex: DFCI Oncologist Completes First PMC

When Paul Schaye, a 10-year PMCer and new cancer patient, asked his Dana-Farber oncologist, Dr. George Demetri, to ride with him in the PMC, Demetri shrugged him off. As the Quick Family Senior Investigator in Medical Oncology and Director of the Ludwig Center at Boston's Dana-Farber/Harvard Cancer Center, he kept long hours and rarely exercised.

"I don't have time to train," Demetri told him. "I mean, I'm literally trying to cure cancer here."

But Schaye persisted. Over the months of seeing Dr. Demetri for treatments meant to keep his stage IV stomach cancer at bay, Schaye hammered away at his doctor, who would become his friend, to ride on "Paul's Posse," a team of 50 power players from New York and Boston gathering to ride in the PMC and earmark the funds they raised for Dr. Demetri's research.

Demetri ultimately acquiesced to the pressure, registered to ride, and finally thought it would be a good idea to buy a road bike—in May! And then he did nothing until a month or so before the PMC when he thought a little training might be wise. "I did one 35-mile ride before the PMC, a 25-mile ride, and a couple of 18-mile rides that I rounded up to 20. That was about it," Demetri said.

But together with Dr. Gary Schwartz, Schaye's oncologist from Memorial Sloan-Kettering, a cycling novice whom Schaye had also convinced to ride, Demetri pushed down on one pedal and pulled up on the other, over and over again, with the goal of making it from waterstop one to waterstop two. Then from waterstop two to waterstop three, waterstop three to waterstop four... all the way until Sunday afternoon, when somewhere within

a long stream of cyclists, donning light blue Paul's Posse PMC jerseys, Drs. Schwartz and Demetri swept past the dunes of Truro and breezed into Provincetown, finishing the 190-mile ride at the Provincetown Inn.

"I couldn't believe it!" Demetri exclaimed. "No drugs, no steroids, no blood doping and we made it anyway!"

Demetri credits the other members of Paul's Posse, most of whom were experienced cyclists, for pulling them along and motivating him to keep pedaling. "They had a No Doc Left Behind policy," Demetri said. "Someone was always riding with us to make sure we stayed with it. It was really incredible to receive two days of intense training and instruction on how to ride."

Demetri says he was as proud of his accomplishment as he was humbled by the experience. "I saw former and current patients all along the way," he said. "And to see all the people lined up along the side of the road, from village to village—I realized the massive impact that Dana-Farber has. I felt it was impossible to stop riding."

On Monday morning, Demetri says he was "downright shocked," when he realized what he'd accomplished. "It was a privilege to be a part of it all and I look forward to doing it again next year."

And in an inspiring, karmic, PMC-way, the experience helped a well-respected, accomplished, and even famous oncologist feel the gratitude for his patient that his patients often feel for him. "I am deeply thankful to Paul Schaye because I couldn't have done it without him. He helped me reconnect with the deep impact that our work has on our community. And he gave me the chance to prove to myself that I could ride the entire PMC."

## Survivors Who Ride Are Living Proof of the PMC's Success

### Father-Daughter Chemo Team Rides 190 Victorious Miles

The day John Coughlin found out his 21-year-old daughter Sarah had non-Hodgkin's lymphoma was the day "the whole descent into Hell began," he says.

Sarah, who was about to enter her senior year at Notre Dame, had a tumor the size of a softball pressing on her heart.

Sarah underwent surgery, followed by months of chemotherapy and radiation treatments. Little did John know, he would soon have a much greater understanding of what his daughter was experiencing.

A few short months after Sarah was diagnosed, a routine colonos-

copy revealed that John had a large tumor and stage III cancer. He went on to endure 11 months of radiation and chemotherapy and two major surgeries. "When Sarah was diagnosed, I always said if I could only take her cancer and have it instead of her, I would, but this was not exactly what I had in mind," he said.

John went through radiation first, and got to tell Sarah what to expect. They would often drive together from their home in Duxbury to Boston for treatment. The two leaned on each other every step of the way and tried to remain positive. They were known as the "father-daughter chemo team," at the oncology ward.

Four years after their diagnosis, John and Sarah can gladly say they dodged not one, but two bullets. And this past summer, the two confronted another physical test together, except this one was voluntary and a lot more fun.

Side-by-side, John and Sarah celebrated their clean bills of health by riding 190-miles from Sturbridge to Provincetown, as the ultimate living proof team.

"I will always be proud to be a part of the PMC and its mission. The PMC makes you feel alive and like

you're saving lives, all at the same time," said Sarah.

### A Year of Healing Culminates for Virginia Woman

Mary Beth Gibson, 43, of Toano, Va., was diagnosed with breast cancer one month after a mammogram detected nothing.

"I went home and cried because I thought I was going to die," recalled Gibson. Instead, she had a double mastectomy, five months of chemo and radiation treatments, started a blog through which she documented her year of healing, founded a support group entitled "Beyond Boobs," and started training for her first PMC, which she completed in August 2007.

Today, Gibson is cancer-free and her life has changed. "I don't say, 'some day,' anymore and I don't talk about doing things. I do them," she said. "If I want to do something now, I plan for it right away."

Gibson said her freshmen experience riding in the PMC ranks as one of the best days of her life.

"I was just amazed, almost speechless at the outpouring of community support I witnessed. I was just so touched and when I crossed the finish line in Bourne, I could barely keep it together. The same time the

## 23 PMC Kids Rides Raise \$465,000 for the Jimmy Fund

Kiana Rain Hawley has never known her Uncle David without cancer; he was diagnosed with Hodgkin's lymphoma the year she was born. Two years ago, Kiana found a way to help her uncle and others like him. She started riding her bike, complete with training wheels, in the PMC Kids Ride—Marblehead and raising money for cancer research. Since then, Kiana, just six years old, has raised more than \$17,000 as a PMC Kids Ride cyclist.

The first grader is but one of a growing number of young philanthropists who are making a difference by raising money for cancer research through the PMC. This year, nearly 3,500 children, ages 3 to 14, rode in 23 PMC Kids Rides and raised \$465,106.84 for the Jimmy Fund as a result.

The 23 PMC Kids Rides are all different, with routes that range from short obstacle courses for "tykes on trikes" to full marathon (26 miles) distances. A freshman ride in Hingham alone raised more than \$64,000 and drew more than 500 young cyclists. Since 1998, when the program was started by Ryan and Hattie Wilkinson in Medfield, PMC Kids Rides have raised nearly \$1 million. PMC Kids Rides are completely organized and run as volunteer efforts by children and their families.

"Children are no longer as shielded from illness, injury, or other aspects of real life that can be painful or upsetting," said PMC Founder and Executive Director Billy Starr. "Kids continue to surprise all of us, all the time. They want to be involved; they want to contribute, and we believe that children, just like adults, become healthier, more complete people because they participate."

# Team MFS Rides for its Own



For nine years, PMC sponsor, MFS Investment Management has sent cyclists and volunteers to the PMC, paired with Pedal Partners from the Jimmy Fund Clinic, and has annually contributed financially to the event. But this year, the PMC became personal. Team MFS rode in honor of nine-year-old Maddie Savoie, daughter of MFS employee Emie Savoie.

Team MFS, made up of 43 employees and MFS family members, rode all 190-miles for Maddie, who was in 2006 diagnosed with Ewing's sarcoma, a type of bone cancer. Maddie's doctors discovered tumors in her hip, lungs and skull, and she was treated with chemotherapy and radiation.

Maddie spent time with the team both before and during PMC weekend; at their annual pedal partner lunch, John Reilly, senior vice president and director of public relations, presented Maddie with a Teddy bear wearing an MFS T-shirt signed by all

"The PMC means a lot to MFS and its employees. It's a great fit with our model of employee-based philanthropy. # For Hundreds, the PMC is About the Children of the Jimmy Fund Clinic

For 15-year rider and volunteer Rik Clark, 77, of Osterville, the heart of the PMC is found in dozens of children who serve as the PMC's Pedal Partners.

Each year since 2001, when the PMC started its Pedal Partner Program, Clark has ridden in honor of a child being treated for cancer at the Jimmy Fund Clinic. "The program is a wonderful way to directly connect with a family that is dealing with cancer," says Clark. "It makes the PMC that much more personal and the riding becomes easy when compared to what these families are going through."

Clark really gets involved with the families of the children for whom he rides. Throughout the years, he has visited his Pedal Partners in the hospital, at their homes, and even attended their family parties and events. But getting close to Pedal Partners and their families is not without some risk. Three out of seven of the children Clark has been paired with have passed away.

"It's so emotional, I can't even explain it," Clark says. "I just try to

be there for the family to offer support. At the worst time in their lives, I am an extra friend who cared about their child. I try to help out during their time of need."

Clark continues to stay in touch with all of his Pedal Partners' families. During the PMC that followed the death of one of Clark's Pedal Partners, the child's family members cheered him on as he road along the route. One reached over and stuffed money into his jersey and thanked him for riding. "I was so surprised by the gesture because I would never expect a Pedal Partner family to raise \$1,500 toward my campaign."

"It's especially hard for me to ride by the Pedal Partner photos PMC weekend with a dry eye," says Clark.

In its seventh year, the PMC's Pedal Partner Program connects PMC cyclists with children who are being treated at the Jimmy Fund Clinic for whom they ride and raise money. The young oncology patients become part of a large group of people who are committed to helping fight cancer. PMC cyclists offer mentorship

previous year I was in chemotherapy and there I was on a bike. I just felt so glad to be there and so lucky to be alive," Gibson said.

## Cancer Survivor Comes from Atlanta to Ride in PMC

By the time Atlanta restaurateur and commercial realtor Warren Bruno was diagnosed with non-Hodgkin's lymphoma in 2006, the cancer had spread to 80 percent of his body. The next six months were fraught with aggressive chemotherapy treatments that drastically altered his busy lifestyle.

"It took everything out of me. I had to stop my life," he said. "I was bed-ridden and once the treatments were through, it took another six months to begin to feel normal."

In the wake of his recovery, Bruno, a Wellesley native, signed up for the PMC despite some lingering concerns that his body would not be up for such a difficult task. Warren trained and fundraised rigorously in the months leading up to the ride, but said he was not prepared for what would unfold PMC weekend.

"I was totally blown away," Warren said about the physical challenge of the ride and emotion that enveloped the entire weekend. "I just lost it when I rode into the Dighton lunch stop and saw all the photos of the Pedal Partners lining the road."

Warren celebrated his 59th birthday over PMC weekend, is today cancer-free, and has returned to his busy lifestyle.

# St. Paul Students See the U.S. and Raise Money for the PMC

This past June, eight teenagers from a Concord, NH boarding school were looking forward to the infamous cross country rite of passage—dipping their bicycle wheels in Puget Sound, Wash., as a kick-off to their coast-to-coast virtual PMC ride.

But on this particular June day, the Sound was beyond reach. It was low tide when they arrived at the shoreline and carrying out this tradition would have meant trudging through thick, wet sand with hybrid bikes in tow. With thoughts of the thousands of miles of open road that lay before them, the St. Paul's School seniors decided to improvise.

"We found a puddle and dipped the wheels in there instead," said 17-year-old Grant Wilson, a San Francisco native and one of the students who cycled across the northern border of the country (and a bit of Canada too) to raise \$57,000 for the PMC.

The resourcefulness and sense of humor that got them through that first day would come in handy as they encountered frequent and grueling uphill rides, heavy winds, wrong turns, flat tires, sore muscles and plenty of strange characters along their journey.

All of the students are athletes, but not a single member of the group had ever ridden more than 50 miles in a stretch before embarking on this 4,000-mile trip.

Between the June 14th start in Bay View, Wash., and the July 29th finish in Northeast Harbor, Maine, the group averaged 90 miles a day, took just six rest days in total, and slept in churches, hostels, private homes, and the occasional motel along the way. They relied on a support van, driven by parents or family members who were on a rotating schedule, for camping equipment, bike replacement parts, and food.

Choosing the Pan-Mass Challenge as the charity to fund was something that everyone in the group could emotionally connect to. "We thought of many different charities, but raising money for cancer research made sense to all of us. Everyone has been impacted by cancer," said Wilson.

Another member of the group, Sophie Everts, a Concord, Mass. native, said the cause not only resonated with the entire team, but also with strangers along the route. "People across the entire country who heard our story were really touched that we were riding for cancer research. Most of the people we met had either been directly or indirectly affected by cancer, I feel so fortunate to be blessed with health that allowed me to complete a cross-country ride," said Everts.

Riding for a cause they could relate to became a big motivating factor when their untrained, sore quads faced steep, mountainous hills. "The second day was the worst in the whole trip," Wilson says, thinking back to the Cascade Mountains. "I was so sore, but I kept reminding myself that we were riding for cancer research." To emphasize their mission, the youth visited the Ronald McDonald House in Seattle and in St. Paul where they met several pediatric cancer patients.

On the last day of the trip, the team took care of some unfinished business. With huge smiles on their faces, the students from St. Paul's rode straight into the marina of Northeast Harbor and then mugged for photos, ankle deep in chilly northeastern waters.

# New Wellesley One-Day Loop Draws 330 Cyclists

To John Blanchflower, 48, of Sterling, the new one-day, Sunday, Wellesley to Wellesley loop provided a way to honor his sister and sister-in-law whom he lost to cancer, as well as show solidarity with his father who is currently battling terminal lung cancer. He was relieved to find an avenue into the event, since the traditional routes had been sold out.

"We are not alone in this disease. Everyone had a story to share and we encouraged each other along the way," Blanchflower says. He says he received an extra push along the PMC route from his sister, sister-in-law, and his wife's sister who died as a child from a rare form of cancer. "At the bottom of each hill, I'd ask the girls to give me a push, and they did. I had wind at my back the whole time."

Blanchflower was one of 330 PMCers who rode in the newest PMC

route, which started and ended at Babson College in Wellesley. "The additional riders made the Sunday finish line that much more vibrant and exciting," said Jeff Rimpas, Wellesley hub site coordinator. Perhaps more importantly, the additional riders brought an additional \$775,000 to the Jimmy Fund.

"The purpose of creating the new route was to increase the PMC's ability to accept more cyclists and fundraisers to the PMC, expand the Wellesley finish line and enhance its party atmosphere, all without adding extra bodies and bikes to the Mass. Maritime Academy hub site," said PMC Founder and Executive Director Billy Starr. "Mission accomplished. We expect to annually increase the number of riders to this new route."

# PMC Shapes Corporate Culture

Just like people and families, companies are also impacted by cancer.

SolidWorks, a software development company headquartered in Concord, Mass, was first impacted by cancer in 2002 when Chris Berg, a friendly and hard working 29-year-old SolidWorks engineer, lost his life to the disease. That year, in Berg's honor, six SolidWorks employees participated in their first PMC, raised \$29,000, and unknowingly started a solid tradition of giving back that has become one of the company's hallmarks.

Within two years, the team grew to 41 cyclists and then cancer found Team SolidWorks again. In 2004, they rode in honor of five-year-old Erica who had acute lymphocytic leukemia, and is the daughter of a SolidWorks employee Eric Lindquist. SolidWorks family members who have conquered cancer, like young Erica, or who lost their lives to the disease, have fueled the growth of Team SolidWorks. Word spread quickly through the company about the personal and charitable rewards that come with being involved in PMC weekend.

This year, 78 people rode on the SolidWorks team. Together they raised nearly \$500,000 for the PMC. As team numbers increased every year and the Jimmy Fund gained valuable support for cancer research, the company profited just as handsomely, participants say.

The PMC sparked a wave of socially responsible activities among employees and the event went on to become the centerpiece of a broad, company-wide Community Giving Program.

# Keeping Biker Buns Warm Since 2002

It's midnight on a Saturday; do you know where your mother is?

If it's the first weekend in August, she might be having her annual "Ladies Night Out," except this crew won't be home until the next morning. These party moms are busy making breakfast at Mass Maritime Academy for thousands of cyclists taking on day two in the Pan-Mass Challenge. They start at midnight and finish at 8 a.m.

"Only your true friends will come out at midnight," says Wende O'Brien, founder of Ladies Night Out, which has become the unofficial name of MMA's volunteer breakfast team. "I heard the Pan-Mass Challenge was in need of 12 volunteers. I made a couple of phone calls; it wasn't a hard sell. As mothers, we rarely get the chance to go out and stay up late. The night is full of fun and laughter. We chat the whole time while we work. None of us miss the one night of sleep."

The women that participate in Ladies Night Out range in age from 40 to 73-year-old Mary Lou Alfano, who is O'Brien's mother. Also known as "The General," Alfano is one of the 40 volunteers who do everything from slicing fruit to setting-up chairs and tables, to assembling 2,500 of the PMC's infamous "biker buns," bacon, eggs and cheese sandwiched in English muffins.

But O'Brien has more than adrenaline and coffee running through her veins during those wee-hours of the morning. She is filled with gratitude, she says. When her 12-year-old son, Schuyler, was diagnosed

with Ewing's sarcoma he received overwhelming support from Dana-Farber. "I will volunteer here until the day I die," says O'Brien, "I am just so indebted to the Jimmy Fund. The least I can do is put breakfast on the table for the people riding 190-miles and raising money for cancer research. The first weekend in August is booked from here on out."

Almost all of the Ladies Night Out crew has been touched by cancer in some way; two are breast cancer survivors. Each year they gain new members looking to join in on the night of fun and over the past two-years they have even gained one male member, Schuyler O'Brien, now 17-years-old.
